Planning and Executing a Major Genealogy Road Trip by Bill Hewitt

A Special Program on Genealogy Road Trips

Bill has been conducting family genealogy research for over 30 years. Over the course of those years he has made a number of 1-week research trips in pursuit of the descendants of all of his Gr-Gr-Grandfather Hewitt's six children. In 1996 he began writing a narrative history of him and his descendants while continuing his research. In 2009 he decided to bring the book to a close. With that thought in mind he planned one last trip of approximately 3 weeks to the Midwest to address some loose ends, attempt to resolve some family myths, and to meet some recently found cousins. Afterwards, he incorporated the new information and images into the book and published it for family and select libraries in July 2010.

It is that final road trip that he will be talking about with emphasis on planning for it in order to maximize the efficiency of time and discussing how he resolved issues that arose during the trip.
