## Murder and Consequences - A Family Story -

This is a one-hour presentation of a family tragedy wherein two female family members were found guilty of the murder of an illegitimate newborn infant and were subsequently sentenced to death circa 1841 in northern England. Details of the research into this saga are presented as we follow the life of one of the women who is transported to a British penal colony in Van Diemen's Land, now called Tasmania. The saga of the ship's journey is totally reminiscent of the "Mutiny on the Bounty". The story collides with some major world history events and famous personalities that resonate up to the present day. Alert: Not a "How To" and not intended for anyone who might be squeamish or sensitive.
