REMINDER:

- [TITLE] is the full name, no matter how long, of book.
- [SHORT TITLE] is an easily recognized shortened form of the title, *if* that title is overly long. Otherwise, repeat the title.
- [WEBSITE TITLE] is the name of the hosting website.
- [RECORD TYPE] indicates the format of the web publication; e.g., “web edition” or “digital images.” Enter in lower case, but note that capitalization may be incorrect in the Bibliography.
- [AUTHOR] is entered in the form “Surname, GivenName.” Separate names of multiple authors with semicolons. If the author is a corporation, etc., use the backslash (\) before any commas. This converts the comma to a special character and it is copied as is. Example: Film Study Center\, Harvard University. This way, it doesn’t follow the name rules, but prints out the same way in the Full Footnote, Short Footnote, and Bibliography.
- [AUTHOR ROLE] could be “compiler,” “editor,” “translator,” etc., or leave blank.
- [SECOND AUTHOR] is the creator of the hosting website.
- [PUBLISH DATE] is the year of the original publication.
- [YEAR POSTED] is the year the book was posted online. If not available, enter the year you saw the online book. This can be updated to a range of years, if the site is revisited.

- [URL] should be the URL for the book, if not too long. Otherwise, use the main URL for the hosting website.
- [PUBLISHER] is the name of the original publisher.
- [PUBLISHER ADDRESS] is the place of publication; typically City, if well-known, or City, State.
- [CD1] is the page number(s).
- [CM] is used for analytical and explanatory notes about this source as it pertains to the specific event being cited.
