What did you find when you analyzed your records? Was more research required in order to complete this assignment? Did you need a new tag? How did you formulate your source citation? Your journal report should be as long or short as your source requires. Write at least a two-paragraph narrative.

No need to worry about knowing how to cite history sources, our editors can assist you with this task. Photographs should also be emailed as separate files and labeled. Please include possible captions for each item. Photographs, when scanned, should be in either .jpg or .tif format. Finally, please provide a headshot and short bio (50-60 words) with an email address. Your headshot and bio will be placed at the end of your article so that members, readers, and unknown relatives can easily contact you.

By submitting an article for publication in the Livermore Roots Tracer, you agree to grant the Livermore-Amador Genealogical Society one-time print publication rights, and the right to publish the article on its website in the Roots Tracer Archive. 
