Stealing from the Dead

One of my immigrant ancestors, Maria Theresia Hannemann (my 4th great grandmother) was the daughter of Jadocus Heinrich Hannemann. She immigrated to the US with her husband from Osterwick, Germany.

Jadocus Heinrich Hannemann, her father, was the first gravedigger in Osterwick and settled into his duties for 22 years. He started his role at the churchyard's opening in August 1808 after blessing by priest, Mathias Jurgens, and stopped when he was fired for grave robbery...

After each burial, he would take the iron fixture from the casket and resell it. Over and over again.

He got fired and went to prison for 14 days.
