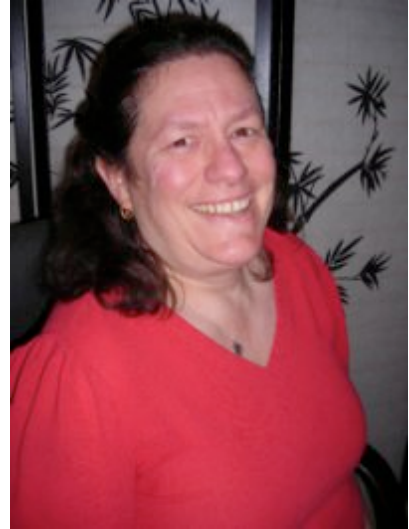

Vital Records and the Calendar Change of 1752

This talk introduces the wealth of information found in birth, marriage, and death records. Learn how to obtain vital records created at the various levels of the U.S. government: federal, state, county, and town. The talk will cover not only the usual places researchers look for vital records but some unusual sources you probably wouldn't think of. There will be also a discussion of the calendar change of 1752 (and similar changes in other countries) and how it affects genealogical research.

Janice M. Sellers is a professional genealogist who specializes in forensic, Jewish, and newspaper research. She is the vice president of the San Francisco Bay Area Jewish Genealogical Society and the editor of three genealogy journals. She is also a member of the Association of Professional Genealogists, the Genealogical Speakers Guild, the California Genealogical Society, and the African-American Genealogical Society of Northern California, among others. She has been on the staff of the Oakland FamilySearch Library since 2000.
